As of November 1, 2009, virtually all healthcare providers and many entities that provide aging services throughout the United States will be required to comply with new privacy and security requirements to prevent identity theft and implement an identity theft prevention program. These new requirements are referred to as the Identity Theft Red Flags Rule and are enforced by the Federal Trade Commission. Violation of the Rule can result in per instance civil monetary penalties of \$3,500. Compliance requires covered entities develop and implement identity theft prevention programs in compliance with the Rule. This presentation will provide background regarding the Red Flag Rules, assist participants to understand the applicability of the Rule, and discuss strategies of implementation.
