



MDS 3.0 One-Day Training for Nursing Facility Staff

The Minimum Data Set Version 3.0 (MDS 3.0) is due to be implemented by CMS for skilled nursing facilities across the nation on Oct. 1, 2010. The word is that this change is more comprehensive and significant than initially anticipated. Be sure to train your staff early and often so they will be prepared to accurately complete this important assessment tool, which plays such a major role in facility reimbursement, survey outcomes and quality measures!

Important: This training is designed for staff already familiar with the MDS. For staff who need or want more comprehensive training, please see the two-day MDS/RAI course.

Objectives:

- ✓ Become familiar with the new MDS assessment forms and their use
- ✓ Understand the new coding conventions for retained as well as new MDS items
- ✓ Differentiate between and know when to do resident interviews vs. staff interviews
- ✓ Learn the new Care Area Assessment process, including the two new care areas (Pain and Return to Community)
- ✓ Know what impact the new MDS 3.0 will have on the LTC survey process
