



Navigating MDS 3.0: RAI Training for Nursing Facility Staff

The **new MDS 3.0** will be required as of Oct. 1 – will your facility be ready? Consultants and state agency staff who attended the MDS 3.0 training in Baltimore say the change from MDS 2.0 is not the “revision” they initially expected – the MDS 3.0 is a complete replacement of the old tool, and there is a lot of new information for your staff to learn! How your nursing facility staff completes and uses the MDS 3.0 can directly impact resident quality of care, survey outcomes, your publicly posted quality measures and your reimbursement. Make sure your staff know how to do the job right the first time!

This two-day course is the most comprehensive MDS 3.0 training offered in Oregon, taught by Demi Haffenreffer, a nationally-recognized long-term care consultant and expert in the RAI and MDS.

In this training, participants will review:

- ✓ **All** sections of the MDS 3.0 and rules pertaining to each
- ✓ The Care Area Assessment (CAA) Process
- ✓ The PPS schedule
- ✓ How the MDS is used in the survey process
